We will be making cards for our Daddy's and can't wait to see you at our 'Play & Make' morning!

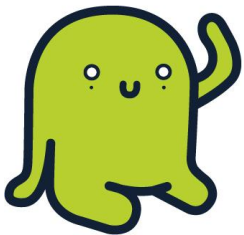
