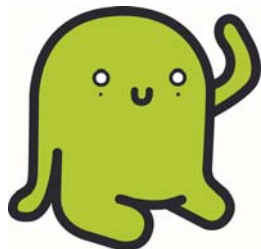
Michelle and the babies have joined with the Tiny Tots room as the babies are old enough and more mobile to play alongside the young toddlers.
